NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- **SAFETY** of the dogs is our primary concern.
- **BY ENTERING THIS TRIAL**, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **IT IS EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD** that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- **WORKERS**: Volunteers are the heart of an agility trial. Without you we can't do it! Please volunteer to work at least one class each day. Thank you!
- **DUPLICATE SCRIBE SHEETS**: Bo-Gee Agility is offering competitors duplicate scribe sheets!! Be sure to pick yours up right after your run! They will be located ringside.
- **PARKING**: There is ample parking at this site.
- **PRIZES & AWARDS**: Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each level in each class. Dogs with an "NT" (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing all legs in a specific level (CL-2, CL-3, etc.) and those dogs completing Level 5 individual titles. Those dogs earning their C-ATCH, CS-ATCH or C-ATE will be awarded special rosettes and bars.
- **SET UP** will be allowed on Friday afternoon. Please check your final confirmation for details and times.
- **DISCIPLINARY PROBLEMS** will be reviewed by the Trial Committee, and appropriate action WILL be taken if necessary. Please keep your dog a safe distance from other dogs. Not cleaning up after yourself, your guests, and your dog(s) is a disciplinary problem. You will be dismissed from the trial if you fail to clean up!
- **FLAGGED/ROPED OFF AREAS** are off limits to competitors. Do not move ropes without the express permission of the Chairperson. Competitors are not to rope off any areas without the express permission of the Chairperson.
- **CONFLICTS**: Please tell the gate stewards of BOTH RINGS and we'll do our best to accommodate you! Conflicts should be minimal.
- **CAMPING/RVs**: RVs are allowed at this site. Please fill out the form in this Premium. Selection of sites will be first-come, first-served. **There IS a dump station available. Check your final confirmation for details.**
- **KEEP DOGS LEASHED**: Please keep dogs in control and don't allow dogs to run loose. **THIS RULE WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED.** YOUR DOG(S) IS NOT ALLOWED OFF LEASH EXCEPT IN THE RING DURING ITS RUN OR IN THE WARM-UP AREA!!!!

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles shall be used.

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. Exhibitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs.
- Exhibitors must verify their entry information and report any discrepancies to the show secretary by the closing or move up date for the trial. The show secretary is not obligated to make changes at the trial if it is the exhibitor’s error. No changes will be made once the trial has been completed when the handler did not report an error before or at the trial.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.

- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

There is no training in the ring at a CPE agility trial. First offense will result in an excusal from the run. Further offenses will result in additional excusals for the day/weekend per the judge’s discretion. This is for the safety of the dog.

The following items *are not* considered training in the ring (also see FEO):

- Dog grabbing it’s leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items *are* considered training in the ring:

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals.

- **ENTRY ACCEPTANCE METHOD; ENTRY CLOSING DATE; PRETRIAL MOVE-UP DEADLINE:** See cover page.
- **PRETRIAL MOVE-UPS:** Must be received **in writing**. Send by email to TSS@trialsecretary.com. The notice of the move-up must identify dog, handler, dog's CPE number, current classes and levels entered, and what classes need to be moved up one level. All move-up requests will be acknowledged. If you do not receive an acknowledgement, please inquire with the trial secretary. TSS cannot be responsible for emails not received.
- **ENTRIES:** The first attempt at resolving an issue on an entry form will be made by email. If no response is received by the competitor within a reasonable amount of time, the Trial Secretary will telephone. Please include a legible phone number and a legible e-mail address on your entry form.
- **DISCOUNT:** Take advantage of the discount and postmark your entries by March 10!! See the entry form.
- **MOVE-UPS FROM SATURDAY TO SUNDAY:** Bo-Gee is offering move-ups from Saturday to Sunday at the trial in classes that are offered more than once. Please submit your request for a move-up within 30 minutes of scores being posted for the class on Saturday.
- **ENTRY STATUS:** If you want to check the status of your entry, please visit the Trial Secretary's web site, www.trialsecretary.com, where the current list of competitors can be found. The list is updated periodically as entries arrive.
- **REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date. However, a 50% refund of entry fees for injuries to dogs or handlers, or bitches in season, will be given if the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary **ON OR BEFORE Monday, April 26 at Noon ET**. The request **MUST** be in writing and **MUST** be accompanied by a **dated letter** from your Veterinarian (or Doctor, if the injury is to the handler) **on your Veterinarian's (or Doctor's) letterhead** with a brief description **explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete**. Also, no entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **BAD CHECKS** for ANY reason will incur a \$30.00 charge, in addition to bank charges. All entry fees will be deposited immediately following the closing date. **Please plan accordingly!!**
- **FOREIGN COMPETITORS:** Fees must be submitted in United States Funds. Also, if your money order, business check or personal check, is not written on a United States bank account, include a \$6 fee with your entries.
- **CPE DOG REGISTRATION:** See Page 3.
- **OVERPAYMENTS:** Overpayments of entry fees will not be refunded. Please check your math carefully!
- **CONFIRMATIONS:** Final Confirmations will be emailed to all competitors that provide an email address within one week after the closing date. PLEASE let the Trial Secretary (TSS@trialsecretary.com) know if you have not received your confirmation by then. Preconfirmations will be emailed as entries are received. If you wish to see who is entered in the trial, check the TSS web site, where a list of Competitors will be posted, and updated periodically.
- **GENERAL COMPETITORS' BRIEFING** will be given following measuring and check-in, prior to the first class briefing. Competitors not attending the general briefing will still be subject to the terms and conditions set forth in such a briefing. Neither the judge nor the host club is required to provide details of the general briefing once it has been given. Only those competitors with dogs requiring measurement are required to check-in.
- **MEASURING AND CHECK-IN:** 7:00 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Saturday and 7:15 a.m. to 7:30 a.m. Sunday. Judge's briefing and the judging of the first class will start after course building is complete, at 8:00 a.m. or earlier. **Review your final confirmation** for updated information and potential Friday check-in and measuring opportunity. Only those handlers with dogs that do NOT have a permanent height card are required to be checked in. **ONLY JUDGES ARE ALLOWED TO MEASURE DOGS. PLEASE BE ON TIME FOR MEASURING!** A list of dogs requiring measurement will be posted on the TSS web site a few days before the trial. If your dog is on that list, you must be present during the above measuring times.

The show secretary is not obligated to make changes at the trial if it is the exhibitor's error. No changes to results (except a club's scoring error) will be made once the trial has been completed when the handler did not report an entry or move-up error.
