NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

- **SAFETY** of the dogs is our primary concern.
- **BY ENTERING THIS TRIAL**, competitors acknowledge that they are familiar with CPE rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- **IT IS EXPRESSLY UNDERSTOOD** that competitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and/or children. Any competitor whose dog(s) and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- **COMPETITOR SET UP** will be allowed on Friday afternoon after 2:00 p.m. We welcome you to set up Friday.
- **PRIZES & AWARDS:** Placement ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place in each height in each class. Dogs with an “NT” (no time) are not eligible for any ribbons in any class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Junior Handlers will receive qualifying rosettes in the Standard classes. Title rosettes will be awarded to dogs completing all legs in a specific level (CL-2, CL-3, etc.) and those dogs completing Level 5 Championship and Level C Extraordinaire individual titles. Those dogs earning their C-ATCH, CS-ATCH, CT-ATCH and C-ATE will be awarded special rosettes and an additional special award. Please let us know before the trial if you’re close to finishing a C-ATCH or equivalent.
- **DISCIPLINARY PROBLEMS** will be reviewed by the Trial Committee, and appropriate action WILL be taken if necessary. Please keep your dog, and you, a safe distance from other dogs. Keep dogs leashed. Please keep dogs in control and don’t allow dogs to run loose. *All dogs must be on leash except when in the ring or warm-up area.*
- **CLEAN-UP** at the show site and at the motels is a must! You will be dismissed from the trial if you do not clean up after your dog(s).
- **WORKERS:** Volunteers are the heart of an agility trial. Without you we can’t do it! Whatever you can do to help out is appreciated! We will feed you and thank you profusely! In addition we have some very cool raffle prizes only for workers!
- **A WARM-UP JUMP** shall be provided for all entered dogs. Competitors may not use the warm-up area to relieve their dogs. Other equipment may not be used for the duration of the trial.
- **FOOD, COLLARS, TOYS AND TRAINING DEVICES** are not allowed on course. No collars are allowed when the dog is running a course.
- **OBSTACLES:** See below.
- **CONFLICTS:** Please tell the gate stewards of BOTH RINGS and we’ll do our best to accommodate you! Conflicts should be minimal. If, after all entries are in, we determine that a class needs to be moved to another ring to get us all out of there earlier, we will do that! This will be a low-stress trial! Please don’t worry – you will get your run!
- **VETERINARIAN:** Phone 603-357-2455 and listen for recorded message indicating which Veterinarian Office is on duty for the weekend. Have paper and pencil ready to write down the phone number you are given.
- **HUMAN MEDICAL:** Emergency - Phone 911. The physical address of the Cheshire Fairgrounds is 247 Homestead Highway, Swanzey, NH 03446. The address of the human hospital is Cheshire Hospital/Dartmouth-Hitchcock Clinic, 580 Court Street, Keene, NH (603) 354-5400
- **RULES:** Please visit www.k9cpe.com for complete rules and regulations regarding entering this trial.
- **THE TRIAL RING:** No exhibitor, spectator, or their children and/or dog may be in the agility trial ring, which is currently not in use, FOR ANY REASON. Any such instance will result in an excusal from the balance of the trial, without refund of entry fees. Spectators shall be excused from the trial site. There are no exceptions. Dogs not entered in this trial may NOT use any equipment (including the warm up equipment). For purposes of this trial, “Spectator” is defined as any person on show grounds that does not have a dog entered in the trial. No spectators are allowed in the ring at any time, including during walk-throughs. If you are not entered in a class, please allow those that ARE entered to walk their course without extra people. Thank you ☺
- **FOOD VENDOR:** Nikki’s Grill will be serving breakfast and lunch selections.
- **VETERAN DOG HANDLERS:** If your dog is a 16” Veteran jumping 12”, please be sure to tell the timer before you start your run!

OBSTACLES: The following obstacles shall be used.

This trial will be held indoors in an enclosed unheated arena on packed dirt. Ring boundaries will be 40” walls, with the exception of the gate areas, which will have two openings for each ring – one for dogs entering the ring and one for dogs exiting the ring. Crating inside the arena is limited. You are welcome to crate inside the arena PROVIDED your dog is not creating a disturbance and there is space available. Crating inside is on a concrete floor. There is also ample room to set up your shade tents outside the arena, for those of us with rowdy dogs!

Parking is available very close to the arena! You may park anywhere on the grounds, except on roads, driveways, or right next to the building. Please review your confirmation when received for updated information, if any.

PLEASE be safe with your competition dogs. Remember, some dogs just starting out in competition may not want their space intruded upon! Keep your dog a safe distance from other dogs.

DIRECTIONS TO SHOW SITE

From West of Keene: I-91 take Keene, NH exit: Take Route 9 East to Keene. Go straight through the set of lights (Home Depot shopping center is on the left), through the next light (which is where Route 9 continues East, but you keep going straight towards Route 12). Follow straight and go straight through the rotary, and continue straight to Route 12. Turn right on Route 12 South and travel for approximately 4 miles. Cheshire Fairgrounds is on Route 12 on the right. The easiest way to get in the grounds is to go by the first entrance (where the furniture store is) and continue to the next driveway on the right. Our facility is the large arena towards the back of the property.

From East of Keene: Route 101 West. Keep following Route 101 in Keene until you come to Route 12 South and go left at the light (towards Troy). Stay on Route 12 for approximately 4 miles past some car dealerships. Cheshire Fairgrounds is on Route 12 on the right.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

General CPE rules for entries/show site:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.
- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.

- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

There is no training in the ring at a CPE agility trial. First offense will result in an excusal from the run. Further offenses will result in additional excusals for the day/weekend per the judge’s discretion. This is for the safety of the dog.

The following items *are not* considered training in the ring (also see FEO):

- Dog grabbing its leash at the end of a run (if the run has not yet ended, the dog would receive an NT)
- Asking the dog once for a sit or down on the table in the point games (asking more than once will be a delay of finish, 5 faults/points)

The following items *are* considered training in the ring:

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.

- **SPECIAL THANK YOU:** As a special thank you to the folks who are attending our LAST Ruff Agility trial in New England, we want to offer you a chance to win your entry fees back! We will draw one dog's name each day at Noon and that lucky dog will get a 100% refund of their entry fees!! The more dogs you enter, the better your chances. You must be present to win and claim your prize, or, sadly we'll need to draw another name. So don't go anywhere at Noon each day! Limited to one refund per competitor.
- **VOLUNTEERS:** THANK YOU!! If you volunteer, and you know you are not going to arrive by the start of the first class, please indicate that on your worker form. Thanks!
- **CPE DOG REGISTRATION:** All dogs entered in CPE Trials MUST be registered with CPE prior to the trial's closing date to compete. A membership form is available online. CPE rules state that new dog numbers must be received by the closing date to the trial. Please be sure to mail your application to CPE at least a couple weeks before the closing date for the trial! Visit CPE's website, www.k9cpe.com, to obtain a dog registration form. Also, see Page 4.
- **WAITING LIST:** A waiting list, if necessary, will be maintained until the closing date.
- **OPENING DATE, ENTRY ACCEPTANCE METHOD, ENTRY CLOSING DATE:** See cover page.
- **MOVE-UPS PRETRIAL:** **Monday, September 27 at Noon**, which must be received **IN WRITING**. Email your moveups to tss@trialsecretary.com. The notice of the move-up must identify Club, dog, handler, dog's CPE number, current classes and levels entered, and what classes need to be moved up one level. **Move-downs** will NOT be accommodated after the closing date. Please be sure to enter the level for which you are eligible when you fill out this entry form.
- **MOVE-UPS (not move-downs) FROM SATURDAY TO SUNDAY** will be allowed in the Standard and Jackpot classes. Please fill out the move-up form provided at the ribbon table within 30 minutes of the posting of scores for that class on Saturday.
- **BAD CHECKS** for ANY reason are subject to a minimum \$30.00 charge, in addition to bank charges. All entry fees will be deposited immediately following the closing date. Please plan accordingly.
- **REFUNDS:** Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. There shall be no refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date. However, a 50% refund of entry fees for injuries to dogs or handlers, or bitches in season, will be given if the request is received in writing by the Trial Secretary ON OR BEFORE Monday, September 27 at Noon, or when entry limits are reached, whichever occurs first. The request MUST be in writing and MUST be accompanied by a **dated letter** from your Veterinarian (or Doctor, if the injury is to the handler) **on your Veterinarian's (or Doctor's) letterhead** with a brief description **explaining the reason the dog, or the handler, cannot compete**. Also, no entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- **CONTACTING COMPETITORS WITH QUESTIONS ON ENTRIES:** Please be sure to furnish a **legible** email address on your entry form. The first attempt at contact will be by email. The second attempt will be by telephone. The third will be returning the entry and check to the competitor.
- **FOREIGN CHECKS:** All fees must be submitted in United States Funds payable through a United States Bank. If your check is not payable through a U.S. bank, please include a \$10 fee with your entry fees. FYI – Canadian Postal Money Orders are NOT payable through a U.S. Bank.
- **COMPETITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE** for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms. Overpayments of entry fees will not be refunded. Underpayments of entry fees do not constitute a valid entry. **PLEASE CHECK YOUR MATH!**
- **MEASURING:** Will be held 4:00-5:00 p.m. Friday and 7:00 until 7:15 a.m. Saturday and Sunday. **Review your Final Confirmation** for updated information and times for Friday measuring. A list of dogs requiring measurement will be posted on the TSS web site a few days before the trial. Only competitors with dogs requiring measurement are required to check-in. ***There will be no measuring of dogs after judge's first briefing each day. All dogs without a permanent card must be measured before the judge's briefing to show that day. There will be no exceptions.*** Only dogs entered in this trial will be measured.
- **GENERAL COMPETITORS' BRIEFING** will be given following measuring and check-in each morning, prior to the first class briefing. Competitors not attending the general briefing are still subject to the terms and conditions set forth in such a briefing. Neither the judge nor the host club is required to provide details of the general briefing once it has been given.
